

The Ruhr-University of Bochum is one of the leading research universities in Germany. As a reform-oriented campus university, it uniquely combines the entire range of the major scientific disciplines in one place. The dynamic community of disciplines offers extraordinary opportunities of interdisciplinary collaborations to researchers and students alike.

The University Hospital of the Ruhr University of Bochum (UK RUB) is an affiliation of qualified hospitals and specialised medical facilities in the Bochum, Herne and East Westphalia-Lippe region that cooperate with the RUB. The UK RUB stands for patient care at the highest level and excellent research and teaching in university medicine.

To strengthen the research in oncology, the Medical Faculty calls for applications for a

Full Tenured Professorship (W2) for “Health care research in Oncology”.

The research profile of the position will focus on the field of oncological health care research and should develop a research and teaching area in „diversity medicine in oncology“.

The Ruhr-University's Oncology is part of RUCCC (Ruhr University Comprehensive Cancer Center). The candidate is expected to aid its progression to become an oncological center of excellence within a regional network.

The position includes the management of the university branch in Bochum. For this reason, prerequisites for applying include experience in the coordination of interdisciplinary networks, interest in tasks such as public relations, project management and the implementation of joint translational research.

The professorship is not linked to its own clinical unit. It is envisioned that the candidate will be involved in the organisation of the Molecular Tumor Board in coordination with other oncological departments and in ongoing and perspective research collaborations.

We are looking for a candidate with leadership experience in the field of cancer medicine. The formal requirements include a habilitation, positively evaluated junior professorship, or, alternatively, academic achievements of equal quality. A professional specialist certificate in a field related to cancer medicine is desired, but not obligatory. Applicants should be nationally and internationally recognised for their research in the field of oncology, preferably with a focus on health care research. They should ideally have experience in the self-administration of a university faculty and in establishing new teaching formats.

In addition to outstanding scientific qualifications, a track-record of successful third-party funding and the willingness to participate in the self-administration of the faculty, further requirements are:

- Pedagogical aptitude and dedication to teaching
- The willingness to do interdisciplinary research
- The willingness and ability to apply for and attract third-party funding for research projects

The candidate is expected to integrate into the research areas of the faculty (oncology, neuroscience, and protein science). We expect the candidate to participate in clinical-scientific collaborations with institutions of the medical faculty of the UK RUB in existing research topics and developing fields as well as possible prospective collaborative research projects.

RUB stands for diversity and equal opportunities. Therefore, we support the cooperation of heterogeneous teams and the career of people that are underrepresented in the respective areas. We particularly welcome the application of female candidates, which, in case of equal qualification, are preferentially considered. We also welcome applications from candidates with disabilities.
