A doctorate of outstanding quality, proof of particular aptitude for academic teaching and a positively evaluated junior professorship, habilitation or equivalent scientific achievement are required.

Applicants should demonstrate outstanding achievements in research and teaching and strengthen one of the key areas of the Faculty of Medicine (neurosciences, protein sciences, oncology) and/or the development area of pathogen-host interactions. The future post holder should represent the field of biochemistry and molecular biology in research and teaching. Experience in teaching medical students is desirable.

The followings are also expected

- a high level of commitment to teaching
- a willingness to engage in interdisciplinary scientific work
- the willingness to participate in academic self-administration
- the willingness and proven ability to acquire externally funded research projects
